

Are you looking for creative tools to inform and engage the people of your church for “the least of these”? She Is Safe offers speakers and resources for churches, small groups, and Bible study groups to join what God is doing to free and empower abused and exploited women and girls.

- **January - National Slavery and Human Trafficking Prevention Month:** 98% of sex slaves are female. As the new year begins, your church can take an active role to free and empower women and girls from abuse and slavery. Consider using the She Is Safe G-rated 2 minute anti-trafficking video.
- **February - Valentine’s Day:** Love holds deeper meaning when it serves a kingdom purpose! Your church can share love and engage in the freedom and empowerment of women and girls.
- **March - Give Life for Lent:** Help your church prepare hearts for Easter by connecting with a world in need of resurrection. **Give Life for Lent** is an opportunity to mobilize the body of Christ to use the money saved from giving up certain items during Lent to help free and equip girls in the toughest places on Earth. In just six weeks leading to Easter, you can change a life forever.
- **April - Spring:** As new life blooms, we can join with Heaven and celebrate the new life that God is bringing to enslaved women and girls around the world!
- **May - Mother’s Day:** Use our free “God Gave Us Mothers” video to honor the mothers in your congregation and equip mothers in the world’s hardest places with training, tools, and the message of God’s love. These empowered women become shining examples of hope for their daughters, sewing the seeds for a brighter future!
- **July - Freedom in Christ:** As Americans celebrate our Independence Day, we seek to connect this national holiday with God’s global and eternal work to set captives free.
- **August - Back to School:** For girls where SIS works, education also means a chance at freedom. SIS provides an inspiring look at the transformational power of education in the life of a young girl in the least-reached world.
- **October - Day of the Girl:** The UN has declared October 11 “International Day of the Girl.” We have an adorable brief video that celebrates the potential of girls to address global issues and bring God’s love to bear fruit in the least-reached places around the globe.
- **November - Forgotten Girls:** As She Is Safe approaches the year-end, we work with all our partner churches to say “thank you” for a year of freedom and empowerment, and to remember that the girls who have been “forgotten” by the world hold the tools to create real, positive change in families and communities.
- **December - Christmas Treasures:** We celebrate the treasured gift of new life in Christ that our co-workers are sharing with at-risk women and girls in the least-reached world. You can place the faces of treasured girls we help on a Christmas tree, and invite people to give so they can be free.
